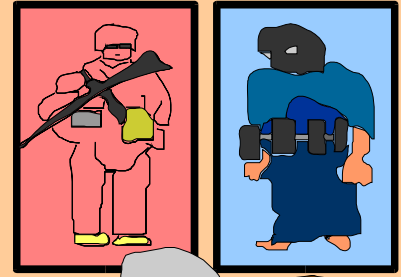


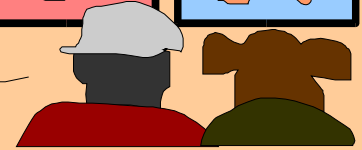

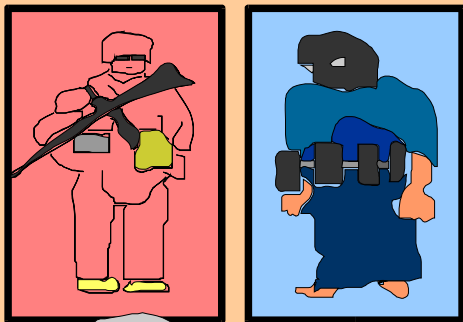
The suicide bomber and the US Marines have some things in common, I think.

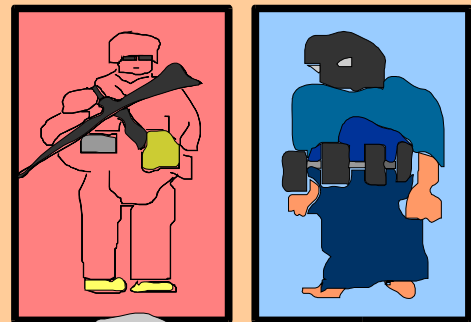


I think it's time for you to stop now.



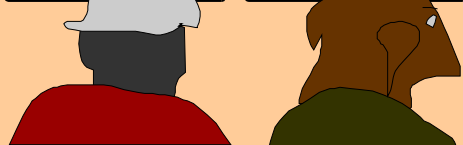
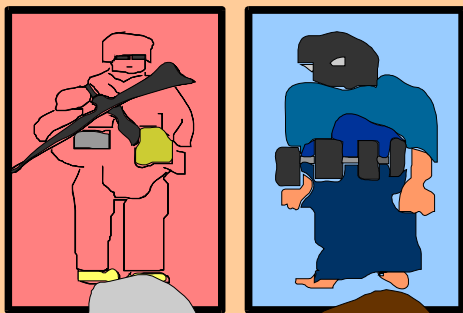
The suicide bomber is considered an *absolute* hero by his people. So is the US marine.

Shut up, right now! You don't even live in these countries!



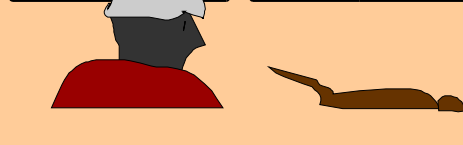
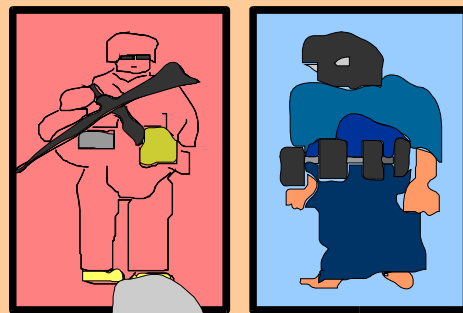
